MANAGEMENT STUDIES

In the 21st Century, leaders will have to respond to rapid changes in their careers. Students learn to lead, manage and execute, as well as to develop, implement and communicate innovative ideas and creative solutions. This curriculum focuses on real-world leadership & innovation management in a variety of industries rather than one specific discipline.

TECHNOLOGY STUDIES

Students will develop the knowledge and hands-on skills to specialize in one of the 9 pillars of Industry 4.0: Big Data and Analytics, Autonomous Robotics, Simulation, System Integration, Internet of Things, Cybersecurity, Cloud Operations, Additive Manufacturing and Augmented Reality.
